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## **CCU ANNOUNCES APRIL AND MAY 2010 VOLUMES**

(Santiago, Chile, June 14, 2010) – CCU reported today preliminary consolidated volumes for April and May 2010.

After the earthquake impact on the first quarter volumes reported on April 7, 2010, CCU is exceptionally providing sales volumes variations for the bimester compared to the same period in 2009, which can be found in the updated Investor's Presentation available in our web site as of today.

The preliminary volume breakdown by segments in hectoliters is as follows:
